CAMPERSHIP GUIDELINES- OLD NORTH STATE COUNCIL, BSA - 2022

- A campership award will pay for one-third of the camp fee. A campership award will pay for one-half of the encampment weekend fee.
- 2. A Scout's parents/caretakers must provide income and employer information on all campership requests. The reason for the campership may be one of the following: single-parent family with limited income, medical hardship with limited income hardship, multiple youth from the same family household attending which presents a financial hardship to attend camp.
- 3. The unit and the unit's sponsoring organization should also provide financial support for camperships.
- 4. A Scout is thrifty! The Scout should sell *Trails End* Popcorn, sell camp cards, or participate in another unit fundraiser to help provide a portion of their camp fee.
- 5. The Scout and a parent or guardian must select one of the options below (a or b) and obtain the approval of the Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Crew Advisor, Ship Skipper. All letters or statements should be attached to the application.
 - Documentation from the school district's nutrition department that demonstrates the Scout qualifies for free/reduced meals.
 - A signed statement from Scout's parent/caretaker's employer or the family's minister that the Scout's parents/caretakers
 have a financial or medical hardship that will prevent them from paying for one week of summer camp.
- 6. A Scout is eligible to receive one campership during each summer camping season.
- Camperships may be applied toward the participation fee for one session of summer camp Scouts BSA Summer Camp, Scouts
 BSA Winter Camp, Cub Scout Overnight Summer Camp, or Cub Scout Day/Twilight Camp sponsored by the Old North State
 Council.
- 8. Scouts from the Old North State Council and from out-of-council are eligible for a campership to participate in an Old North State Council-sponsored Scouts BSA Summer Camp, Scouts BSA Winter Camp, or Cub Scout Overnight Summer Camp. An out-of-council Scout's campership amount will not exceed one-third of the camp fee.
- 9. A transferrable, but nonrefundable deposit must accompany each campership application at the time of submission. The deposit will be applied toward the Scout's camp fee. If the deposit is transferred, it may only be applied toward the camp fee of another Scout that is attending on a full-payment basis. Scouts planning to attend Scouts BSA Summer Camp, Scouts BSA Winter Camp, and Cub Scout Overnight Summer Camp must include a \$20 deposit. Scouts planning to attend Cub Scout Day/Twilight Camp must include a \$10 deposit.
- 10. Camperships are not transferable to another Scout attending summer camp.
- 11. Forms not properly completed will be returned to the unit leader and will <u>not</u> be considered by the Campership Committee until completed properly.
- 12. All campership requests must be properly completed and submitted to the Scout Service Center by the deadline.
- **13.** For Summer 2020, the deadlines are:

Thursday, April 21, 2022: Cub Scout Overnight Summer Camp **Thursday, May 26, 2022**: Cub Scout Day/Twilight Camp

Thursday, April 21, 2021: Scouts BSA Summer Camp Saturday, October 15, 2022: Scouts BSA Winter Camp

- 14. If a Scout is not able to attend camp, the Scout Office should be notified immediately prior to the Scout attending camp so funds can be used for other needed camperships.
- 15. In keeping with the true Scouting Spirit, each Scout receiving a campership is encouraged to write a thank you note to the Camping Committee.
