

Adult Training/Activity Enrollment Sequence

The process for enrolling adults in adult training courses and activities is the same for enrolling Scouts in merit badges/activities.

Adults may enroll in the following trainings/activities prior to camp:

- A. Basic Life Support & Standard First Aid - \$50
- B. Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills - \$30
- C. Paddle Craft Safety
- D. Swim & Water Rescue
- E. 5-Stand Shotgun Shoot - \$25
- F. ATV – if Scouts have not filled all the seats in the ATV course, adult leaders are welcome to participate.
