Wolves: 2 Scouts : 1 Adult Partner

Bears: 2 Scouts : 1 Adult Partner

Webelos: 4 Scouts : 1 Adult Partner

Arrow of Lights: 4 Scouts : 1 Adult Partner

- No doctor signature needed
- Health forms will be submitted online using a tool called CampDoc during the registration process.

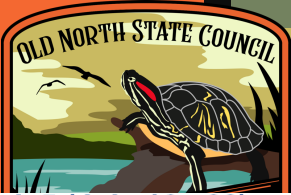
